STAGE 1: ENGAGE

- 1.FIND A LOCATION AND
 DISTANCE WHERE PET WILL
 NOT OVER-REACT TO TRIGGER.

- 3. RIGHT AFTER THE MARK...

 TRIGGER
- 3. REPEAT AT VARIOUS INTENSITIES AS INSTRUCTED
- 4. IF YOU SEE ANY REACTIVITY,
 YOU'VE GONE TOO FAR TOO FAST
 AND NEED GUIDANCE.
