
# Tips for My First Meeting With Your Fearful/Aggressive dog





#### **Meet Outside**

Please have your dog on leash, outside (on the grass, sidewalk, or driveway, wherever he is most comfortable). We can reschedule in inclement weather.

### No corrections or Instructions

Please avoid giving him any corrections (like pulling on the leash or saying "no, ahh ahh, PPSST", etc.) or instructions (like "leave it, look, watch me", etc.) as I approach.






## **Feed Continuously**

Feed and praise frequently as I approach. Even if he's barking or lunging. (Rewarding during "bad behavior" will not encourage it, which we will discuss).

## **High Value Treats**

Please use VERY high-value treats (hotdogs, cheese, chicken, beef, etc.) Heated up makes treats even more enticing! Commercial treats, esp dry ones, typically won't do the trick.





I do not hand-feed uncertain dogs, so I may toss treats. If he is comfortable and relaxed, I may handfeed. I will speak and move as your dog prefers.
